From Barbara . . .

Whom should we love? Who is our neighbor? The first reading gives us with some examples. The neighbor includes not only family members and friends but also aliens or strangers, widows, orphans, the poor and the very neediest in society. In other New Testament texts, Jesus pushes the definition of neighbor to include even enemies. For this purpose the neighbor is not necessarily someone who can offer us repayment or provide some advantage for us. Love of neighbor is not simply enlightened self-interest. Rather, we should love our neighbor because God has loved us first, and in loving our neighbor we respond to God's love for us and repay that love.

Every year the 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time (this weekend) has been designated by the Vatican as World Youth Day. Local churches all around the world are celebrating the contributions that young people make to our communities. In our parishes we are blessed to have many young people serve as music ministers, lectors, ushers, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, religious education aides, helpers at Colorfest, the Labor Day festival, and the yard sales, and in our outreach ministries by making casseroles, helping with our Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter programs, and participating in work camp. I'm sure I haven't mentioned everything so if I forgot to mention your particular ministry I'm sorry but know that our parishes appreciate all that you do because of your faith. I also want to thank all the various adults who work with our young people by walking the faith journey with them.

In our parish survey we asked how we could change the Mass schedule to address the shortage of priests as the Archbishop has asked us to. Almost to a person, each of the respondents was open to any change except to the Mass that they usually attend. If we should need to change the Mass schedule everyone will be asked to adjust their routine when it comes to attending Mass. At this time we are not making any changes but probably will have to in the not too distant future.

May God continue to bless us all.
